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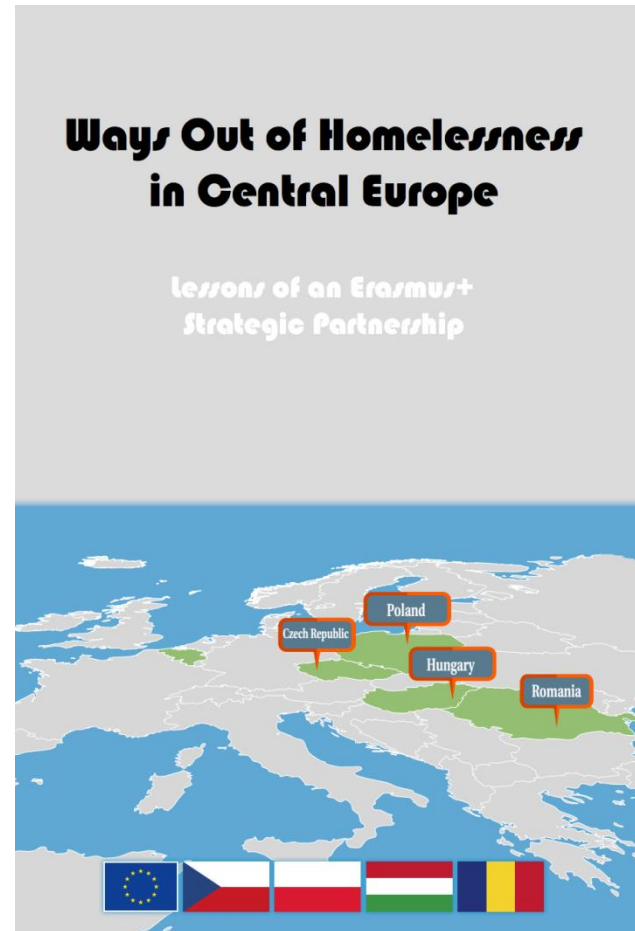

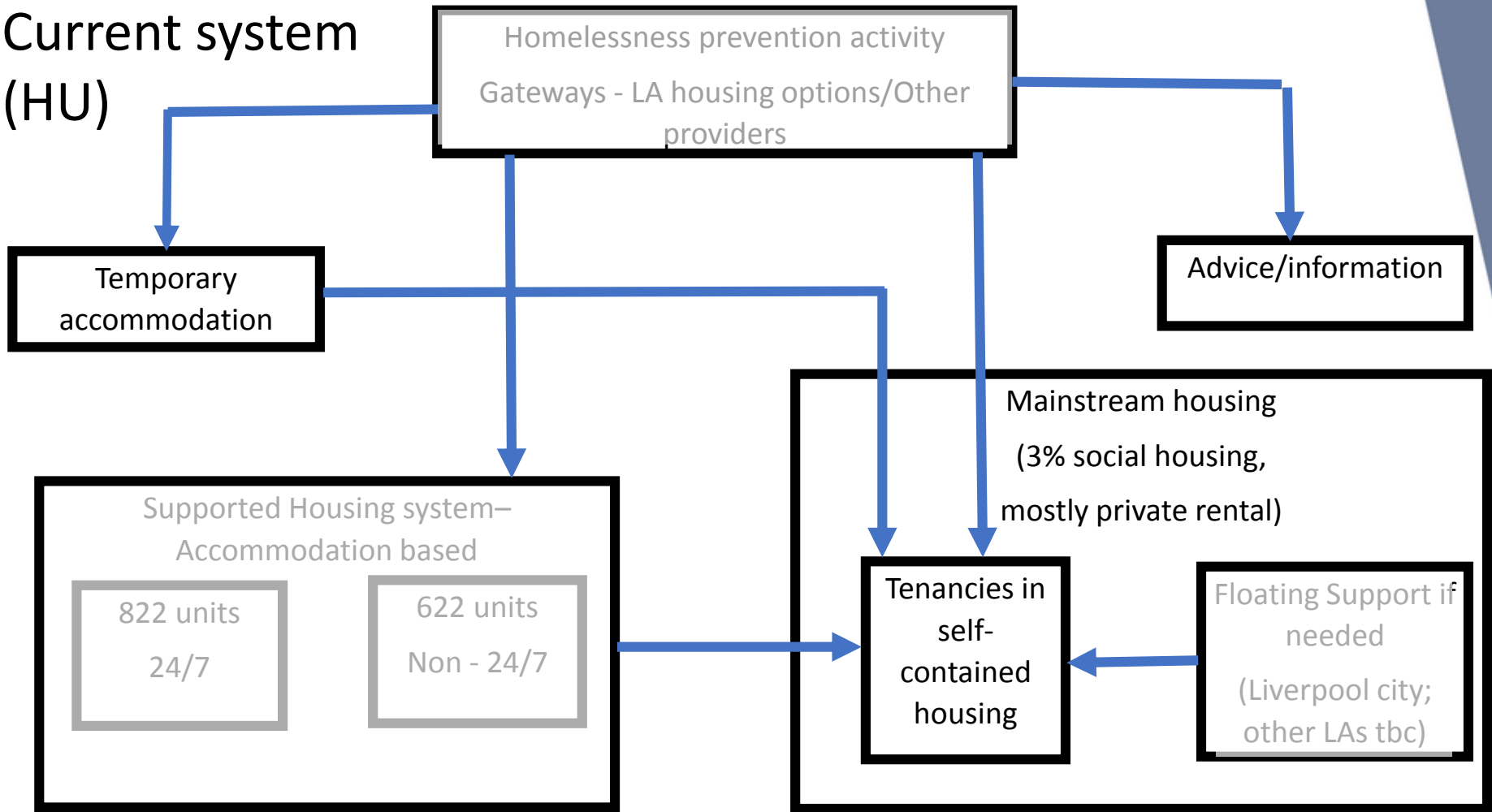

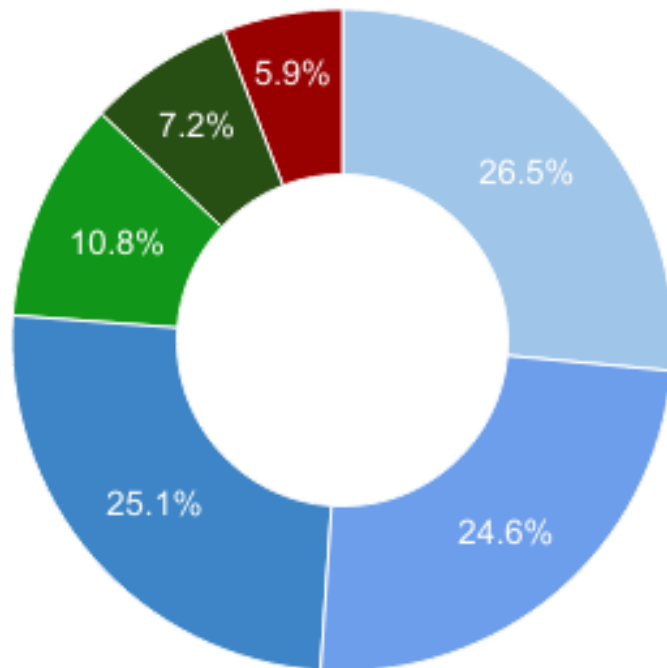

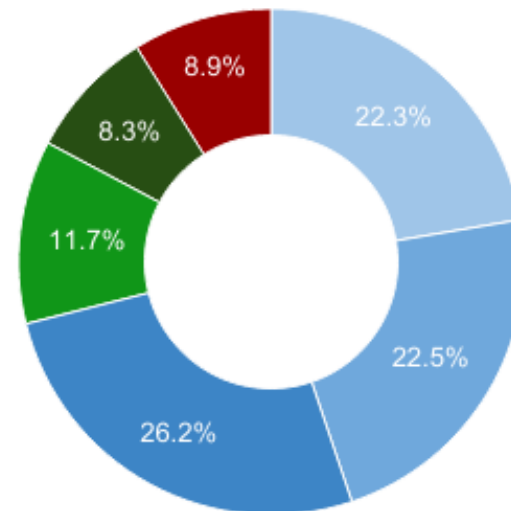

What do homeless people think?

(Feb 3, 2017; N=8071)

- 4 out of 10 people think they would have difficulty living on their own (with no support)
- 2 out of 10 people mentioned a health condition/disability that would hinder their independent living
- 5 out of 10 people mentioned a fear of sustaining housing due to „bad habits“
