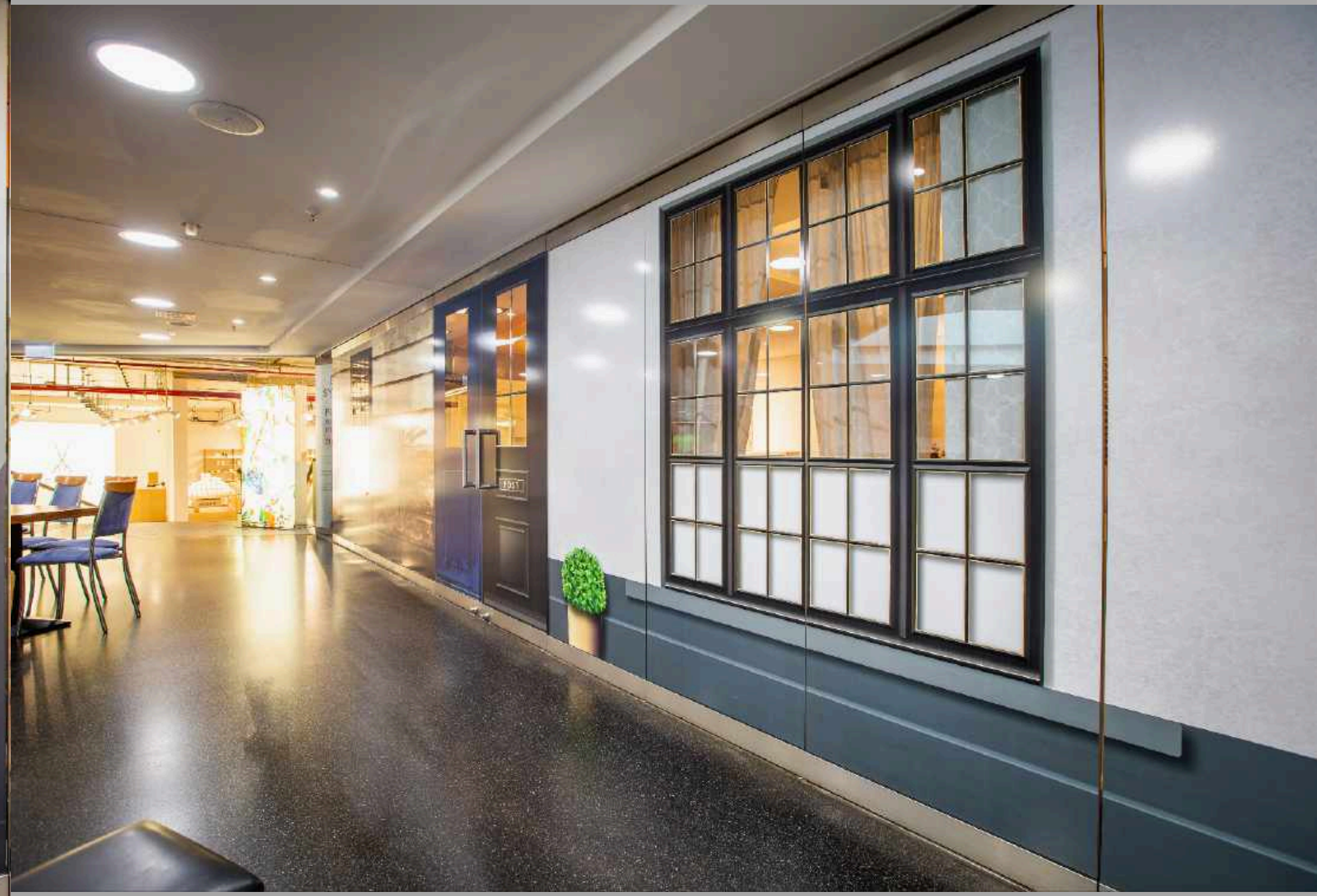

- *An escape room is a great thing to try with a bunch of friends or workmates.*

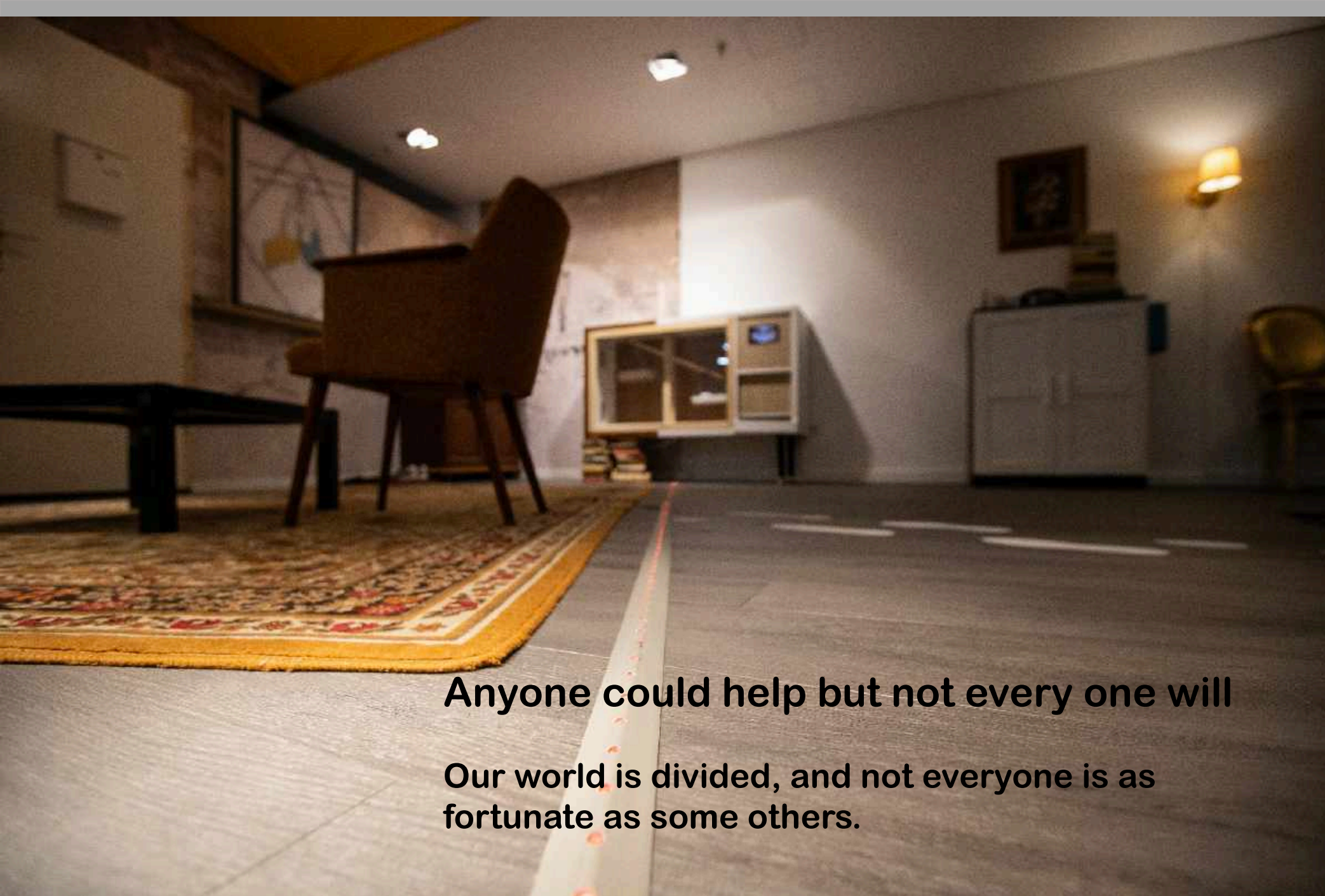

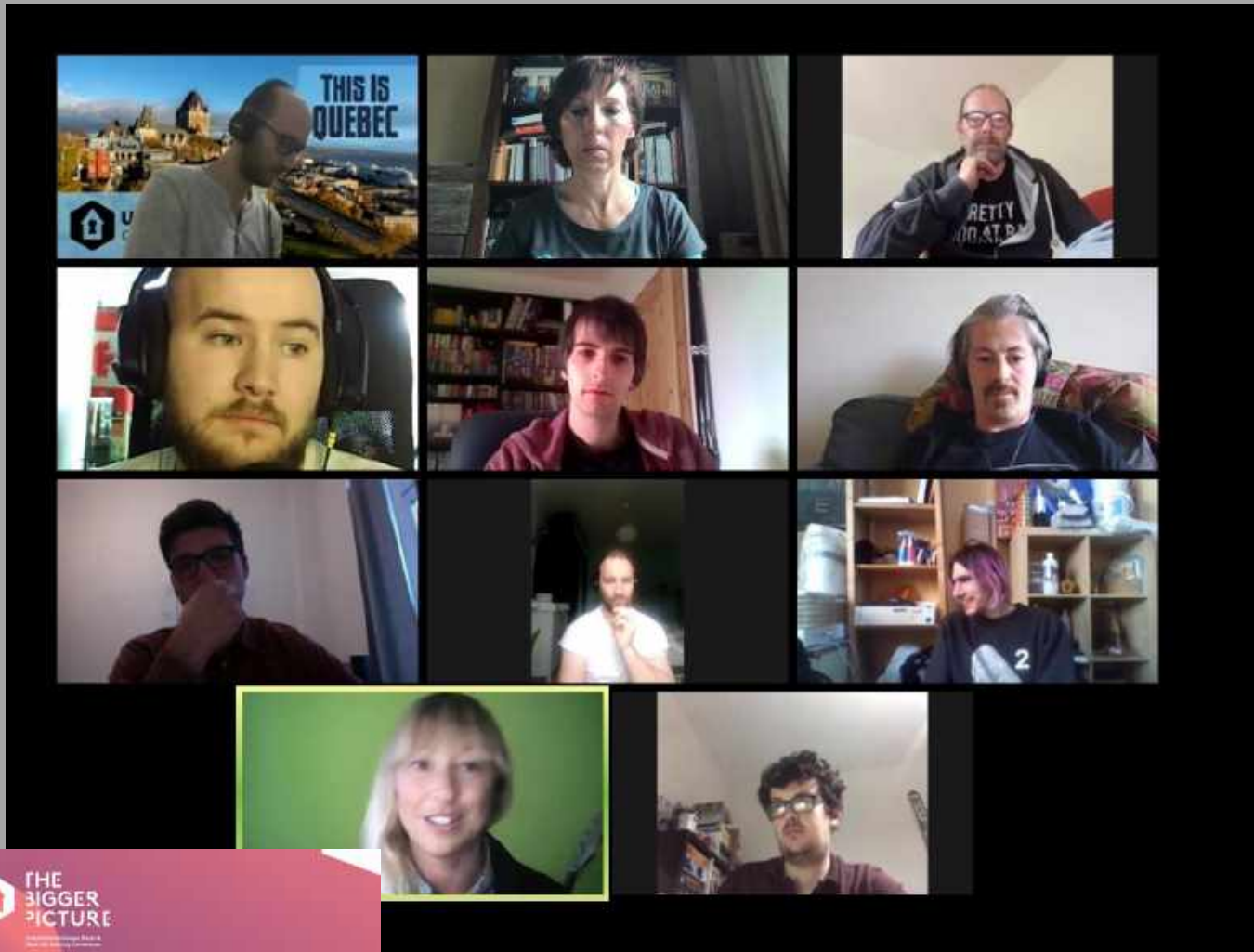

A HOMELESS-THEMED ESCAPE ROOM? GET OUT!

Office workers around the country are being dragged to escape rooms in the run up to Christmas. The latest trend for work nights out and staff bonding sessions is for everybody to be locked in a room together undergoing intensive team building as they figure out how to break free. (Other people may well just call this a working office...).

Typical themes involve time travelling, secret missions or zombies, but one room challenges participants to escape something else: homelessness.

In The Divide, players have to solve a series of puzzles designed to reflect homelessness in a room split into two halves.

"Creating a game based around the social divide isn't exactly a 'go-to' theme," says Andrew Ingle of TimeTrap Escape Rooms, based in Reading. "Every puzzle has deeper meaning behind it, with references to food banks and loss of benefit entitlement being some of the issues brought up. We felt that escape rooms have the power to be used as a medium to highlight socio-political issues and get people thinking."

After running in Reading earlier this year, The Divide is opening later this month at Pier Pressure in Brighton. Ingle says that despite most escape rooms being light-hearted and fun, there is potential to tackle tricky subjects.

He explains: "Playing an escape game is often like being in your very own movie – most would probably be compared to an action, thriller or horror. However, some of the most powerful and moving productions are thought-provoking and emotional – films such as *A Street Cat Named Bob*, or *I, Daniel Blake* – so why can't escape rooms also enter these realms?"

With a percentage of ticket sales going to local homeless charities, the aim is for people playing the escape room to help others escape homelessness.
