Key fact on the current situation

GROWING:

- Inflation
 - Prices
 - Interest rates
-
- Most housing stock for rent in private hands
 - More people in need for affordable housing



HFH Poland's Social Rental Program

- Growing prices and costs (unpredictability)
- Bigger apartments
- Less possibility to negotiate
- More trust but less people interested
- Relevancy problem
- Institutionalization



HOMELESSNESS IN POLAND

- around 30 thousand people in homelessness crisis
- in that around 1200 living on streets
- BUT: difficulty (systemic, methodological) in counting the rate
- young people leaving institutional foster care especially vulnerable
- lack of sufficient housing and systemic approach
- BUT: national strategy of deinstitutionalization
