

FIELD VISIT IN BERGAMO

Presentation

The support services and reception facilities for the homeless in Bergamo city comprise a rich and diverse network. For the EOH Research Conference field visit, the network organised three itineraries that will allow participants to visit some of the most representative services of the city, where important projects are underway. All the itineraries will start from the train station and will be guided by a network operator; in some cases, it will be necessary to take local transport. The three itineraries will start at 09:30 and finish at 12:00 (noon).

Meeting point—train station: drop-in service (camper) and the train station soup kitchen. The drop-in service (Monday–Friday from 10:00 to 12:00 and from 14:00 to 17:00) brings in people who are not following a more structured and continuative social service. The drop-in service dispenses clothes and medicine and can go with users to health and social services. The train station soup kitchen (all days from 19:30 to 21:30 and on Sunday from 12:00 to 14:00) gives meals to people at the train station for free. It has 50 seats available.
