VISIT: NIGHT SHELTER 'ÜBERNACHTUNGSSCHUTZ'

Location: Lotte-Branz-Strasse 12, 80939 München

A newly opened low-threshold night shelter for foreign individuals who are not legally entitled to social benefits in Germany, comprising 730 beds.

II:00

VISIT: LIVING SPACES FOR WOMEN

Location: Lieberweg 22, 80937 München

Permanent, individual housing for older women based on Housing First principles, totalling 26 units. Optional social work is available on site.

VISIT: HANS SCHERER HOUSE & MITTENHEIM

Location: Mittenheim 38, 85764 Oberschleissheim

<u>Hans Scherer House:</u> Group accomodation for men in a 'dry facility' offering occupational therapy and work training, as well as health services and sports activities.

<u>Mittenheim</u>: The first of its kind development in Munich wherein a social provider (kmfv) is building affordable housing. 50% of the 420 appartments will be subsidised rental housing.
